Litter will be supplied - please bring your own litter pans.

Show Hours: 10am to 4pm Check in from 8:30 to 9:30 am. Late exhibitors must personally inform all ring clerks of changes. Early departures MUST have permission to leave from the Show Manager in order not to forfeit any wins. This will be strictly enforced.

Show hall directions and hotel accommodations will be sent out with confirmation of entries.

CAGES: The Fundy Fanciers does not provide cages for your cat to hang out in, in between judging. Exhibitors must provide their own. Single spaces are 30" long by 24" wide. Double spaces are 50" long by 24" wide. Anything not cat escapable is allowed and must be covered on 3 sides with visibility of your cat to the public in the front. Fundy Fanciers has a limited number of pop up nylon cages available for new exhibitors. They are available for \$35, come with a bottom pad and case and fit in a single space with no curtains needed. For flying exhibitors, Fundy Fanciers will be pleased to store your cage between shows at no charge.
