This show is sanctioned by the Canadian Cat Association and all rules and regulations will be upheld. A copy of the show rules may be obtained from the Canadian Cat Association. The club sponsoring the show, show committee or any individual member is not liable in the event of a loss or damage to a cat or container.

Listed entries: All cats entered in Kitten, Championship, and Premiership classes must be registered with the Canadian Cat Association. Kitten entries will be accepted with their CCA litter registration number. Non championship entries from other associations may be entered with a listing number for this show. A listing number can be obtained from the CCA office upon payment of a \$10 fee accompanied by the name of the cat, registration number from the other registry, the name of the host club and the date of the show to be entered. Failure to receive payment for entries disqualifies the exhibitor and all his/her cats from future CCA shows until all the debts are paid to the club involved.

Household pets: Must be 4 months of age or over. Cats 8 months and older must be spayed or neutered. Declawed cats are not eligible to show in any class.

Kittens for sale: Kittens must be 3 months of age or over to be in the show hall. Owners must have CCA litter registrations on hand to verify age of the kittens for sale.

This will be a non vetted show. Exhibitors are expected to have current vaccinations and to be free from fleas, ear mites, fungus and disease.

Exhibitor Check in: All entries must check in with the entry clerk. Check in will start at 7:30 am. The show will begin at 9:00 am. Early departure must be approved with the Show Manager in order not to forfeit any wins.

The club will provide litter.
