Additional information concerning entries: All required fees must accompany entry forms. All telephone calls concerning entries will be made collect. No refunds for cancellations. All cats entered in the show must have a CCA registration number, except for kittens who must have a CCA litter registration number and for household pets, and all household pets aged 8 months and over must be spayed or neutered.. Declawed cats are not accepted. CCA does accept listed entries for cats registered with other associations, please contact CCA office for more information. No kitten under the age of 3 months is allowed to be present in the show hall (Registration papers may be requested as proof of age). Litter will be supplied - please bring your own litter pans. The approximate sizes for a single cage are 24" x 24" x 27". All cages must be covered on all sides except the front for the cat's protection and security. CCA offers a rush service for registrations, please contact the CCA office for more information.

Veterinarian: There will be no veterinary check-up prior to the show. Vaccination certificates of all cats in the show hall must be kept up to date and could be requested by the show manager. All cats or kittens for sale MUST have an up-to-date vaccination record and must also be CCA litter registered - both documents could be requested by a member of the show committee.

An entry confirmation with directions and hotel information will be sent to each exhibitor. The show hall is not air-conditioned; however adjacent rooms (judging area, restaurant) are air conditioned and the show hall will be cooled with ventilation from these areas.

Show hours: Saturday: 12:00 – 5 p.m. (check-in starts at 10:30); Sunday: 10 a.m. – 4 p.m.

Official rules: This show shall be sanctioned by the Canadian Cat Association and all its rules and regulations shall be observed. A copy of the Show Rules and Classifications can be obtained for the sum of \$6.00 from the Canadian Cat Association (office@cca-afc.com)
