DEVON REX

The Devon Rex is a breed of unique appearance. It projects a pixie-like image with large oval eyes, moderately short muzzle, prominent cheekbones, large low-set ears, medium fine frame, muscular and covered with wavy fur. The fur has a distinct texture, as the mutation, which causes its wavy coat, is cultivated in no other breed. When guard hairs are fairly thick and higher in number, the coat feels coarser. On the other hand, when guard hairs are almost as thin as the down hairs, the coat feels softer and a tighter ripple will appear. Alert, active and shows a lively interest in its surroundings.

I-BODY/CONFORMATION (25)

(8) BODY - hard and muscular. Medium in length, broad chest with medium fine boning.

(8) LEGS & FEET – Long, medium fine giving an overall appearance of being high on legs. Paws small and oval.

(5) NECK – Medium long and slender.

(4) TAIL - Long, fine and tapering. Covered with short fur.

II - HEAD TYPE (40)

(10) FULL FACE - Full cheeked with considerable width between eyes. Chin strong and well developed. Moderate wedge. Frontal View - Wedge is delineated by a narrowing series of three distinct convex curves - outer edge of ears, cheekbones and whisker pads. Top of head is a flat plane - slight rounding acceptable in kittens.

(10) PROFILE - Nose has a definite stop (approximately 125°^D Forehead curves back to a distinctively flat skull. Though the skull is flat when viewed from front and side, good depth between top of skull and bottom of jaw is evident. Strong chin lines up vertically with nose.

(5) EYES - Large and well set. Oval shaped, sloping to outer edges of ears.

(10) EARS - Strikingly large, set very low and very wide at base. Outside base of ear extends beyond the base of wedge. Round tipped and well covered with fine fur, with or without earmuffs and/or ear tufts. There is a depth (or jug) to the ear, cupping is best viewed from side or back of head. Ears set wide apart on top of head with flat plane on top skull clearly visible.

(5) MUZZLE - Moderately short, well developed with prominent whisker pads.

III – COAT TEXTURE/LENGTH (30)

(15) WAVINESS - A ripple wave effect when coat smoothed with hand. Wave is most evident where coat is longest - body and tail. Density of coat not to be confused with length. Coat is not to be compared with marcelled coats of other Rex breeds.

(10) LENGTH & TEXTURE - Soft, fine, full-bodied and rexed (i.e. - appearing to be without guard hair). Texture may vary.

(5) DENSITY - Well covered with greatest density in

back, sides, tail, legs, face and ears. Slightly less dense on top of head, neck, chest and abdomen. Bare patches in kittens not a fault. Existence of down on underparts of body not to be misinterpreted as baldness. Sparse hair on temples (forehead in front of ears) is not a fault. Allowance to be made for lack of coat in kittens under 8 months.

IV – COLOUR (5)

All colours and patterns are accepted. Any eye colour is acceptable-Preference given for depth, brilliance and evenness. White lockets or buttons are permitted.

V-CONDITION & BALANCE

The cat is to be hard and muscular. Excellent physical condition. Clear eyes.

Apricot is the name used for Cream (based) Caramel. A metallic sheen visibly overlays the base coat colour. Carmelized colours are recognized in all dilute colours and patterns including with white.

SEPIA and **MINK**

Sepia and Mink colours are recognized in all established colours and patterns (except Pointed); including with white (bi-colour, calico, van).

Sepia eye colour is gold or greenish-gold, and odd-eyed (one blue eye and one gold or greenish-gold eye). Sepia coat colour is paler and warmer than the equivalent of traditional colour. The coat colour darkens with age. A slight intensification of colour at the ears, tail, feet and face is noticeable especially in kittens.

Mink eye colour is blue-green to aqua, and odd-eyed (one blue eye and one blue-green / aqua eye). Mink coat colour is much lighter than the corresponding sepia colours and develops more intense colour at the ears, tail, feet and face; than on the body. Sepia and Mink are recognized in: Solids (except black* and white), Smokes, Shadeds, Chinchillas, Golden Shadeds, Golden Chinchillas, Tabbies, Silver Tabbies, Golden Tabbies, Patched Tabbies, Silver Patched Tabbies, Golden Patched Tabbies, Tortoiseshells, Tortoiseshell Smokes, Tortoiseshell Shadeds, Tortoiseshell Chinchillas, Tortoiseshell Golden Shadeds, Tortoiseshell Golden Chinchillas. All established colours and patterns with the addition of white: Bi-Colours, Calicos, and Vans.

Shaded cats are darker (greater amount of pigment on tips/hair shaft) than Chinchillas (or Shells). Legs to be the same tone as face. Preference should be given to the cat whose coat lacks tabby markings.

Nose Leather: Conform to the established colour standards.

Paw Pads: Conform to the established colour standards.

Eye Colour: Silver Shaded and Golden Shaded have green or blue-green eyes.

BLUE SHADED

Coat: White undercoat. The coat on the back, flanks, head, and tail sufficiently tipped with blue, from dark on the ridge to white on the chin, stomach and chest, and under the tail. Legs to be the same tone as face. Shaded cats are darker than Chinchillas or Shells. Preference should be given to the cat whose coat lacks tabby markings.

Nose Leather: Rose.

Paw Pads: Blue or rose

Eye Colour: Green or blue-green.

BLUE SHADED GOLDEN

Coat: Ivory to pale honey undercoat. The coat on the back, flanks, head, and tail sufficiently tipped with blue to enhance golden colour. Ivory to pale honey colour on the chin, stomach and chest, and under the tail. Legs to be the same tone as face. Rims of eyes, lips, and nose outlined with blue. Shaded cats are darker than Chinchillas or Shells. Preference should be given to the cat whose coat lacks tabby markings.

Nose Leather: Rose outlined with blue.

Paw Pads: Blue or rose.

Eye Colour: Green, Blue-Green.

CAMEO SHADED

Coat: White undercoat. The coat on the back, flanks, head, and tail sufficiently tipped with red, from dark on the ridge to white on the chin, stomach and chest, and under the tail. Legs to be the same tone as face. Shaded cats

are darker than Chinchillas or Shells. Preference should be given to the cat whose coat lacks tabby markings. **Nose Leather**: Rose pink.

Paw Pads: Rose pink.

CHOCOLATE SHADED

Coat: White undercoat. The coat on the back, flanks, head, and tail sufficiently tipped with chocolate. White on the chin, stomach and chest, and under the tail. Legs to be same tone as face. GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Coat: White undercoat (Goldens have a rich warm cream undercoat). Coat on back, flanks, head, and tail sufficiently tipped with an established colour or pattern to give the sparkling appearance necessary. Legs may be slightly shaded with tipping. Chin, stomach and chest are white (cream for Goldens). Chinchillas (or Shells) are lighter than Shadeds (significantly less pigment on hair tips and shaft). Preference should be given to the cat whose coat lacks tabby markings.

Nose leather: Conform to the established colour standards.

Paw Pads: Conform to the established colour standards. **Eye Colour**: Golden Chinchilla have green or blue-green eyes.

BLUE CHINCHILLA

Coat: White undercoat. The coat on the back, flanks, head, and tail sufficiently tipped with blue. Legs may be slightly shaded with blue tipping. Chin, stomach and chest are white. Preference should be given to the cat whose coat lacks tabby markings.

Nose Leather: Rose outlined with blue.

Paw Pads: Blue or rose.

BLUE GOLDEN CHINCHILLA

Coat: Pale ivory to creamed honey undercoat. The coat on the back, flanks, head, and tail sufficiently tipped with blue to enhance the golden colour. Legs may be shaded with blue tipping. Rims of eyes, lips, and nose outlined with blue. Preference should be given to the cat whose coat lacks tabby markings.

Nose Leather: Rose outlined with blue.

Paw Pads: Blue or rose.

Eye Colour: Green, Blue-Green.

CAMEO SHELL

Coat: White undercoat. The coat on the back, flanks, head, and tail sufficiently tipped with red. Legs may be slightly shaded with red tipping. Chin, stomach and chest are white. Preference should be given to the cat whose coat lacks tabby markings.

Nose Leather: Rose pink.

Paw Pads: Rose pink.

CHINCHILLA GOLDEN

Coat: Warm pale honey to light apricot undercoat. The coat on the back, flanks, head, and tail sufficiently tipped with black to enhance golden appearance. Legs and end of tail may be slightly shaded with black tipping. Rims of eyes, lips, and nose outlined with black. Chin, stomach and chest are dilute in colour (lighter than undercoat colour). Preference should be given to the cat whose coat lacks tabby markings.

Nose Leather: Deep rose outlined with black ...

Paw Pads: Black.

Eye Colour: Green or blue-green.

CHOCOLATE CHINCHILLA

Coat: White undercoat. The coat on the back, flanks, head, and tail lightly tipped with chocolate. White on the chin, stomach and chest, and under the tail. Legs to be same tone as faceChinchilla cats are lighter than Shadeds. Preference should be given to the cat whose coat lacks tabby markings.

Nose Leather: Brown.

Refer to Breed Standard and General Preface for disgualifications and objections not listed here.

Paw Pads: Cinnamon-pink.

CINNAMON CHINCHILLA

Coat: White undercoat. The coat on the back, flanks, head, and tail lighty tipped with cinnamon. White on the chin, stomach and chest, and under the tail. Legs to be the same tone as face. Shaded cats are darker than Chinchillas or Shells. Preference should be given to the cat whose coat lacks tabby markings.

Nose Leather: Tan to Pinkish Beige.

Paw Pads: Tan to Pinkish Beige.

CREAM CHINCHILLA (CREAM SHELL)

Coat: White undercoat. The coat on the back, flanks, head, and tail sufficiently tipped with cream. Legs and face may be slightly shaded with cream tipping. Chin, stomach and chest are white. Preference should be given to the cat whose coat lacks tabby markings.

Nose Leather: Pink.

Paw Pads: Pink.

FAWN CHINCHILLA

Coat: White undercoat. The coat on the back, flanks, head, and tail lightly tipped with light lavender with pale cocoa overtones. White on the chin, stomach and chest, and under the tail. Legs to be the same tone as face. Shaded cats are darker than Chinchillas or Shells. Preference should be given to the cat whose coat lacks tabby markings.

Nose Leather: Pink.

Paw Pads: Pink.

LILAC CHINCHILLA

Coat: White undercoat. The coat on the back, flanks, head, and tail lightly tipped with lilac. White on the chin, stomach and chest, and under the tail. Legs to be same tone as face. Shell cats are lighter than Shadeds. Preference should be given to the cat whose coat lacks tabby markings.

Nose Leather: Lavender.

Paw Pads: Pink.

SILVER CHINCHILLA

Coat: White undercoat. The coat on the back, flanks, head, and tail sufficiently tipped with black to give sparkling appearance. Legs may be slightly shaded with black tipping. Rims of eyes, lips, and nose outlined with black. Chin, stomach and chest are white. Preference should be given to the cat whose coat lacks tabby markings.

Nose Leather: Brick red outlined with black..

Paw Pads: Black.

Eye Colour: Green or blue-green.

SMOKE

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Coat: Deeply tipped with an established colour or pattern. In repose the cat looks like the established colour or pattern, In motion the white undercoat is clearly apparent. The face, ears, legs, and tail are the established colour or pattern with a narrow band of white at the base of the hairs next to the skin which may be seen only when fur is parted. Preference should be given to the cat whose coat lacks tabby markings.

Nose leather: Conform to the established colour standards.

Paw Pads: Conform to the established colour standards.

NOTE: During seasonal coat colour changes on both kittens and adults, the "reverse" colour of the coat is to be considered a NORMAL coat colour change. At the root it may appear that the primary smoke colour turns white a short distance up the hair shaft and then reverts back to the primary colour. The tipping during this coat colour phase may consume most of the hair shaft with only minimal white colour deep in the coat.

BLACK SMOKE

Coat: White undercoat, deeply tipped with black. Cat in repose appears black. In motion the white undercoat is apparent. Face, legs and tail, black with a narrow band of white at the base of hairs next to skin which may be seen only when fur is parted. Preference should be given to the cat whose coat lacks tabby markings.

Nose Leather: Black.

Paw Pads: Black.

BLUE SMOKE

Coat: White undercoat, deeply tipped with blue. Cat in repose appears blue. In motion the white undercoat is apparent. Face, legs and tail, black with a narrow band of white at the base of hairs next to skin which may be seen only when fur is parted. Preference should be given to the cat whose coat lacks tabby markings.

Nose Leather: Blue or rose. Paw Pads: Blue.



CAMEO SMOKE)

Coat: White undercoat, deeply tipped with red. Cat in repose appears red. In motion the white undercoat is apparent. Face, legs and tail, red with a narrow band of white at the base of hairs next to skin which may be seen only when fur is parted. Preference should be given to the cat whose coat lacks tabby markings.

Nose Leather: Rose.

Paw Pads: Rose.

CHOCOLATE SMOKE

Coat: White undercoat, deeply tipped with chocolate. Cat in repose appears chocolate. In motion the white undercoat is apparent. Face, legs and tail, chocolate with a narrow band of white at the base of hairs next to skin which may be seen only when fur is parted. Preference should be given to the cat whose coat lacks tabby markings.

Nose Leather: Brown.

Paw Pads: Cinnamon-Pink.

CINNAMON SMOKE

Coat: White undercoat, deeply tipped with cinnamon. Cat in repose appears cinnamon. White on the chin, stomach and chest, and under the tail. Legs to be the same tone as face. Shaded cats are darker than Chinchillas or Shells. Preference should be given to the cat whose coat lacks tabby markings.

TABBY PATTERNS

CLASSIC TABBY PATTERN

Markings dense, clearly defined and broad. Legs barred with bracelets. Tail evenly ringed ending in a dark tip. Necklaces on neck and upper chest are to be unbroken. Frown marks on forehead form a letter"M". Unbroken line runs back from outer corner of eye. Swirls on cheeks. Vertical lines over back of head extend to shoulder markings which are in the shape of a butterfly with both upper and lower wings distinctly outlined and marked with dots inside the outline. Back markings consist of a vertical line down the spine from butterfly to tail with a vertical stripe paralleling it on each side. Large solid blotch on each side to be encircled by one or more unbroken rings. Side markings should be the same on both sides. Double vertical rows of buttons on chest and stomach. Hocks to be same colour as markings.

MACKEREL TABBY PATTERN

Markings dense, clearly defined. Legs barred with bracelets. Tail evenly ringed ending with a dark tip Necklaces on neck and upper chest, are to be unbroken. Frown marks on forehead form an "M". Unbroken line runs back from outer corner of eye. Lines run down the head to meet the shoulders. Spine lines run together to form a narrow saddle. Unbroken lines run around the body vertically. Buttons on chest and stomach. Hocks to be same colour as markings.

SPOTTED TABBY PATTERN

Markings dense, clearly defined. Legs barred with bracelets. Tail spotted or broken rings ending with a dark tip. Necklaces on neck and upper chest, are to be broken. Frown marks on forehead form an "M". Line runs back from outer corner of eye. Broken lines run down the head to meet the shoulders. Spine lines consist of broken vertical lines preferably composed of spots. Spots on body may vary in size and shape but should not run together (i.e. a broken Mackerel pattern). Buttons on chest and stomach. Hocks to be same colour as markings.

TICKED TABBY PATTERN

Body hair to be ticked with shades of the marking colour and ground colour. Legs barred with bracelets. Tail evenly ringed. Must have at least one necklace. Frown marks on forehead form an "M". Line runs back from outer corner of eye. Spine line consists of darker dorsal shading. Body colour should be free of noticeable spots, stripes, or blotches. Lighter underside may show buttons on chest and stomach.

PATCHED TABBY PATTERN

An established Classic, Mackerel, Spotted or Ticked Tabby with patches of red or cream.

TABBY COLOURS

BLUE TABBY

Coat: Ground colour pale bluish ivory. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Markings blue. **Nose Leather**: Blue or old rose.

Paw Pads: Old rose.

BLUE SILVER TABBY

Coat: Ground colour bluish silver. Undercoat white. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Markings blue.

Nose Leather: Blue or old rose rimmed with blue. Paw Pads: Blue, old rose or pink

BLUE GOLDEN TABBY

Coat: Ground colour creamed honey. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Markings blue. **Nose Leather**: Blue or old rose rimmed with blue.

Paw Pads: Blue, old rose or pink

BROWN TABBY

Coat: Ground colour coppery brown. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Markings black.

Nose Leather: Brick red.

Paw Pads: Black or brown.

CAMEO TABBY

Coat: Ground colour off white. Undercoat white. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Markings red.

Nose Leather: Pink.

Coat: Ground colour milk chocolate. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Markings a deep, dark chocolate.

Nose Leather: Brown or brick red.

Coat: Ground colour milk chocolate. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Markings a deep, dark chocolate. Undercoat is white.

CINNAMON TABBY

Coat: Ground colour a pale warm honey. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Markings a light reddish brown like a cinnamon stick (lighter than Chocolate).

CINNAMON SILVER TABBY

Coat: Ground colour pale silver with white undercoat. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Markings a light reddish brown like a cinnamon stick (lighter than Chocolate).

CREAM TABBY

Coat: Ground colour pale lavender with a white undercoat. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Markings dark lavender with pale chocolate overtone.

Nose Leather: Lavender pink. Paw Pads: Lavender pink.

GOLDEN TABBY

Coat: Ground colour cinnamon gold to warm honey. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Markings black.

Nose Leather: Brick red.

Paw Pads: Black.

LILAC TABBY

Coat: Ground colour frosty lavender with a pinkish patina. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Markings dark lavender.

Nose Leather: Lavender.

Paw Pads: Pink.

LILAC SILVER TABBY

Coat: Ground colour frosty lavender with a pinkish patina. White undercoat. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Markings dark lavender.

Nose Leather: Lavender.

Paw Pads: Pink.

RED TABBY

Coat: Ground colour cream to dark cream. Lips and chin the same shade as rings around the eyes. Markings red. **Nose Leather**: Flesh or coral pink.

Paw Pads: Flesh or coral pink.

SILVER TABBY

Coat: Ground colour pale silver. White undercoat. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Markings black.

Nose Leather: Brick red.

Paw Pads: Black.

PATCHED TABBY COLOURS

BLUE PATCHED TABBY

Coat: Ground colour bluish ivory. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Markings blue with patches of cream.

Nose Leather: Blue, old rose, may be mottled with pink. **Paw Pads**: Blue, old rose, may be mottled with pink.



BLUE SILVER PATCHED TABBY

Coat: Ground colour bluish ivory. White undercoat. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Markings blue with patches of cream. Fawn patina overcast.

Nose Leather: Blue, old rose, may be mottled with pink. **Paw Pads**: Blue, old rose, may be mottled with pink.

BLUE GOLDEN PATCHED TABBY

Coat: Ground colour creamed honey. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Markings blue with patches of cream.

Nose Leather: Blue, old rose, may be mottled with pink. **Paw Pads**: Blue, old rose, may be mottled with pink.

BROWN PATCHED TABBY

Coat: Ground colour copper brown. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Markings black patched with red.

Nose Leather: Brick red, may be mottled with pink. **Paw Pads**: Black or brown, may be mottled with pink.

CHOCOLATE PATCHED TABBY

Coat: Ground colour milk chocolate. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Markings dark chocolate patched with red.

Nose Leather: Brown, brick red, or cinnamon may be mottled with pink.

Paw Pads: Brick red or cinnamon may be mottled with pink.

CHOCOLATE SILVER PATCHED TABBY

Coat: Ground colour milk chocolate with markings of dark chocolate patched with red. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. White undercoat.

Nose Leather: Brown, brick red, or cinnamon may be mottled with pink.

Paw Pads: Brick red or cinnamon may be mottled with pink.

CHOCOLATE GOLDEN PATCHED TABBY

Coat: Ground colour milk chocolate with markings of dark chocolate patched with red. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Pale honey undercoat.

Nose Leather: Brown, brick red, or cinnamon may be mottled with pink.

Paw Pads: Brick red or cinnamon may be mottled with pink.

CINNAMON PATCHED TABBY

Coat: Ground colour pale warm honey. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Markings reddish brown patched with red.

Nose Leather: Cinnamon may be mottled with pink. **Paw Pads**: Cinnamon may be mottled with pink.

CINNAMON SILVER PATCHED TABBY

Coat: Ground colour pale warm honey. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Markings reddish brown patched with red. White undercoat.

Nose Leather: Cinnamon may be mottled with pink.

Paw Pads: Cinnamon may be mottled with pink.

CINNAMON GOLDEN PATCHED TABBY

Coat: Ground colour pale warm honey with lighter undercoat. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Markings reddish brown patched with red.

Nose Leather: Cinnamon may be mottled with pink. **Paw Pads**: Cinnamon may be mottled with pink.

FAWN PATCHED TABBY

Coat: Ground colour pale lavender with cocoa cast. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Markings warm lavender patched with cream.

Nose Leather: Lavender, may be mottled with pink. **Paw Pads**: Lavender, may be mottled with pink.

FAWN SILVER PATCHED TABBY

Coat: Ground colour pale warm lavender with white undercoat. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Markings warm lavender patched with cream. White undercoat.

Nose Leather: Lavender, may be mottled with pink. **Paw Pads**: lavender, may be mottled with pink.

FAWN GOLDEN PATCHED TABBY

Coat: Ground colour pale warm lavender with pale honey undercoat. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Markings warm lavender patched with cream.

Nose Leather: Lavender, may be mottled with pink. **Paw Pads**: Lavender, may be mottled with pink.



GOLDEN PATCHED TABBY

Coat: Ground colour warm honey. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Markings black patched with red.

Nose Leather: Brick red, may be mottled with pink.

Paw Pads: Black, may be mottled with pink.

LILAC PATCHED TABBY

Coat: Ground colour pale frosty lavender with pinkish patina. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Markings darker lavender patched with cream.

Nose Leather: Lavender, may be mottled with pink.

Paw Pads: lavender, may be mottled with pink.

LILAC SILVER PATCHED TABBY

Coat: Ground colour pale frosty lavender with pinkish patina. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Markings darker lavender patched with cream. White undercoat.

Nose Leather: Lavender, may be mottled with pink. **Paw Pads**: lavender, may be mottled with pink.

LILAC GOLDEN PATCHED TABBY

Coat: Ground colour pale warm honey with lighter undercoat. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Markings darker lavender patched with cream.

Nose Leather: Lavender, may be mottled with pink. **Paw Pads**: lavender, may be mottled with pink.

SILVER PATCHED TABBY

Coat: Ground colour pale silver. Undercoat white. Lips and chin the same shade as the rings around the eyes. Markings black patched with red.

Nose Leather: Brick red, may be mottled with pink.

Paw Pads: Black, may be mottled with pink.



Traditional eye colour is copper, gold, green, or hazel. Eye colour may differ from the norm, please refer to the individual breed standard for additional guidance.

TORTOISESHELL COLOURS

BLUE CREAM

Coat: Blue with clearly defined, patches of cream on face, body and extremities. On the undersides and extremities the colours may fade. A "blaze" which is comprised of the two colours, appears to divide the face down the nose, is desirable.

Nose Leather: Blue, may be mottled with pink.

Paw Pads: Blue, may be mottled with pink.

Objections: Solid colour face, legs and tail. Tabby or brindle markings. Excessive amount of dark cream.

CHOCOLATE TORTOISESHELL

Coat: Chocolate with clearly defined, patches of cream on face, body and extremities. On the undersides and extremities the colours may fade. A "blaze" which is comprised of the two colours, appears to divide the face down the nose, is desirable.

Nose Leather: Cinnamon, may be mottled with pink.

Paw Pads: Cinnamon, may be mottled with pink.

Objections: Solid colour face, legs and tail. Tabby or brindle markings.

CINNAMON TORTOISESHELL

Coat: Cinnamon (reddish brown) with clearly defined, patches of cream on face, body and extremities. On the undersides and extremities the colours may fade. A "blaze" which is comprised of the two colours, appears to divide the face down the nose, is desirable.

Nose Leather: Cinnamon, may be mottled with pink.

Paw Pads: Cinnamon, may be mottled with pink.

Objections: Solid colour face, legs and tail. Tabby or brindle markings.

FAWN TORTOISESHELL

Coat: Warm lavender with clearly defined, patches of cream on face, body and extremities. On the undersides and extremities the colours may fade. A "blaze" which is comprised of the two colours, appears to divide the face down the nose, is desirable.

Nose Leather: Lavender, may be mottled with pink.

Paw Pads: Lavender, may be mottled with pink.

Objections: Solid colour face, legs and tail. Tabby or brindle markings.

LILAC CREAM

Coat: Lilac with clearly defined, patches of cream on face, body and extremities. On the undersides and extremities the colours may fade. A "blaze" which is comprised of the two colours, appears to divide the face down the nose, is desirable.

Nose Leather: Lavender, may be mottled with pink.

Paw Pads: Lavender, may be mottled with pink.

Objections: Solid colour face, legs and tail. Tabby or brindle markings.


TORTOISESHELL

Coat: Black with clearly defined, patches of red on face, body and extremities. On the undersides and extremities the red may fade and appear as cream. A "blaze" which is comprised of the two colours, appears to divide the face down the nose, is desirable.

Nose Leather: Black or dark brown, may be mottled with pink.

Paw Pads: Black or dark brown, may be mottled with pink.

Objections: Solid colour face, legs and tail. Tabby or brindle markings.



ANY COLOUR WITH WHITE

Coat conforms to the established colours and patterns with the addition of white. As a preferred minimum (unless otherwise stated in the breed standard), the cat should have white feet, legs, underside, chest and muzzle. An inverted 'V' on the face is desirable. Nose leather and paw pads conform to the established colour standards. Eye colour is gold to copper, blue, green, hazel, or oddeyed (one blue and one gold/copper eye with equal colour depth). Shaded silver and white, chinchilla silver and white, shaded golden and white, chinchilla golden and white may also have green, blue-green, or odd-eyed where one eye is green or blue-green and the other is blue with equal colour depth.

CALICO / DILUTE CALICO

All established colours and patterns distributed as described for the Calico pattern (a tri-colour cat with un-brindled medium to large patches of DENSE colour and red, or DILUTE colour and cream on a white background). All eye colours are allowed including Odd-eyed (one eye must be blue).

PATTERNED CALICO

PATTERNED CALICO

Coat: A white cat with TABBY patterned patches of established colours with patches of RED (which may or may not be tabby). As a preferred minimum (unless otherwise stated in the breed standard) the cat should have white feet, legs, underside, chest and muzzle. **Nose Leather**: Pink or the established colour.

Paw Pads: Pink, or the established colour.

DILUTE PATTERNED CALICO

Coat: A white cat with TABBY patterned patches of established colours with patches of CREAM (which may or may not be tabby). As a preferred minimum (unless otherwise stated in the breed standard), the cat should have white feet, legs, underside, chest and muzzle.

Nose Leather: Pink or the established colour.

Paw Pads: Pink, or the established colour.

VAN

All established colours and patterns distributed as described for the Van pattern (face and body predominantly white with colour restricted to the head and tail. One or two small spots of colour on the body are allowed): All eye colours are allowed including Odd-eyed (one eye must be blue).



CARAMEL

Caramel is a 'dilute modifier' that affects diluted colours (Blue, Lilac, Fawn, Cream): Blue (based) Caramel, Lilac (based) Caramel, Fawn (based) Caramel. Apricot is the name used for Cream (based) Caramel. The dilute modifying gene does not affect the coat colour of Red cats.

Carmelized colours are recognized in all dilute colours and patterns including with white.

Blue Caramel is medium to dark brownish blue with a purplish cast. Paw pads and nose leather are any shade of taupe with purplish over tone. Should display a metallic sheen especially on the head, up the hocks and around the paw pads. Less evident in kittens.

Lilac Caramel is a cool toned lilac with rich honey brown overtones. Paw pads and nose leather are any shade of taupe with purplish over tone. Should display a metallic sheen especially on the head, up the hocks and around the paw pads. Less evident in kittens.

Fawn Caramel is a warm pale cinnamon with soft blue overtones. Paw pads and nose leather are any shade of taupe with purplish over tone. Should display a metallic sheen especially on the head, up the hocks and around the paw pads. Less evident in kittens.

Apricot (Cream Caramel) is an intense hot pinkish cream. Paw pads and nose leather are pink. Should display a metallic sheen especially on the head, up the hocks and around the paw pads. Less evident in kittens.



SEPIA and **MINK**

Sepia and Mink colours are recognized in all established colours and patterns (except Pointed); including with white (bi-colour, calico, van).

The Sepia and Mink equivalent of Black is Seal.

Sepia: eye colour is gold or greenish-gold, and odd-eyed (one blue eye and one gold or greenish-gold eye). Sepia coat colour is paler and warmer than the equivalent of traditional colour. The coat colour darkens with age. A slight intensification of colour at the ears, tail, feet and face is noticeable especially in kittens.

Mink: eye colour is blue-green to aqua, and odd-eyed (one blue eye and one blue-green / aqua eye). Mink coat colour is much lighter than the corresponding sepia colours and develops more intense colour at the ears, tail, feet and face; than on the body. Please refer to the individual breed standard for description of markings.

SOLID POINT COLOURS

BLUE POINT

Point Colour: Deep grayish-blue. All points should be the same even shade.

Coat: Even bluish-white. Shadings if any are the shade of the points.

Nose Leather: Slate gray.

Paw Pads: Slate gray.

Eye Colour: Clear brilliant blue. Deep blue preferred.

Objections: Improper colour nose or paw leathers. Fawn or cream shadings.

CHOCOLATE POINT

Point Colour: Warm milk chocolate. All points should be the same even shade.

Coat: Ivory without lilac or blue tones. Shadings if any are the shade of the points.

Nose Leather: Burnt rose or cinnamon pink.

Paw Pads: Cinnamon pink to tan-pink.

Eye Colour: Clear brilliant blue. Deep blue preferred.

Objections: Improper colour nose or paw leathers.

CINNAMON POINT

Point Colour: Light reddish brown distinctly warmer and lighter than chocolate. All points should be the same even shade.

Coat: Ivory. Shadings if any are the shade of the points. **Nose Leather**: Tan to pinkish beige.

Paw Pads: Tan to pinkish beige.

Eye Colour: Clear brilliant blue. Deep blue preferred. **Objections**: Improper colour nose or paw leathers.

CREAM POINT

Point Colour: Pale cream. All points should be the same even shade.

Coat: White without toning. Shading if any are the shade of the points.

Nose Leather: Pink.

Paw Pads: Pink.

Eye Colour: Clear brilliant blue. Deep blue preferred. **Objections**: Improper colour nose or paw leather.

FAWN POINT

Point Colour: Light lavender with pale cocoa overtones. All points should be the same even shade. **Coat:** Glacial white. Shadings if any are the shade of the points.

Nose Leather: Pink to light dusty-rose

Paw Pads: Pink to light dusty-rose.

Eye Colour: Clear brilliant blue. Deep blue preferred. **Objections**: Improper colour nose or paw leathers.

LILAC POINT

Point Colour: Light silvery blue with definite warm tones. There may be a slight pink cast. All points should be the same even shade.

Coat: Even glacial white without tan, brown, or blue tones. **Nose Leather**: Lavender pink.

Eye Colour: Clear brilliant blue. Deep blue preferred.

Objections: Improper colour nose or paw leather. Tan, brown, or blue shadings.

RED (FLAME) POINT

Point Colour: Deep orange-red. Kittens may have a lighter shade (hot cream to orange). All points should be the same even shade.

Coat: Warm even creamy white. Shadings if any are the shade of the points.

Nose Leather: Flesh or coral pink.

Paw Pads: Flesh or coral pink.

Eye Colour: Clear brilliant blue. Deep blue preferred.

Objections: Improper colour nose or paw leathers. Pale point colour (overall impression of point colour must be hot). Strong tabby markings.

Withhold Awards: Black or blue patches in nose or paw leathers. Any sign of tortoiseshell pattern.

SEAL POINT

Point Colour: Dense, deep seal -brown. All points should be the same even shade.

Coat: Even pale cream or ivory. Shadings if any are a warm fawn colour.

Nose Leather: Dark seal-brown to black.

Paw Pads: Dark seal-brown to black.

Eye Colour: Clear brilliant blue. Deep blue preferred.

Objections: Improper colour nose or paw leathers. Black or gray shadings.



TORTIE POINT COLOURS

BLUE CREAM POINT

Point Colour: Well defined patches of blue and cream. It is desirable that blue and cream be evident on all point areas.

Coat: Even bluish white. Shadings if any are the shade of the points.

Nose Leather: Slate gray, may be mottled with pink. **Paw Pads**: Slate gray, may be mottled with pink.

CHOCOLATE TORTIE POINT

Point Colour: Milk chocolate with patches of cream. All points should be the same shade. It is desirable that chocolate and cream be evident on all point areas.

Coat: Even ivory. Shadings if any are the shade of the points.

Nose Leather: Cinnamon, may be mottled with pink.

Paw Pads: Cinnamon, may be mottled with pink.

Eye Colour: Clear brilliant blue. Deep blue preferred.

Objections: Improper colour nose or paw leathers. Tabby markings. Lack of two colours on points. Brindled colours instead of patches of colour.

CINNAMON TORTIE POINT

Point Colour: Light reddish-brown with patches of cream. All points should be the same shade. It is desirable that cinnamon and cream be evident on all point areas.

Coat: Even ivory. Shadings if any are the shade of the points.

Nose Leather: Tan to pinkish-beige, may be mottled with pink.

Paw Pads: Tan to pinkish-beige, may be mottled with pink.

Eye Colour: Clear brilliant blue. Deep blue preferred.

Objections: Improper colour nose or paw leathers. Tabby markings. Lack of two colours on points. Brindled colours instead of patches of colour.

FAWN TORTIE POINT

Point Colour: Light lavender with pale cocoa overtones patched with cream. All points should be the same shade. It is desirable that lavender and cream be evident on all point areas.

Coat: Glacial white. Shadings if any are the shade of the points.

Nose Leather: Dusty rose, may be mottled with pink.

Paw Pads: Dusty rose, may be mottled with pink.

Eye Colour: Clear brilliant blue. Deep blue preferred.

Objections: Improper colour nose or paw leathers. Tabby markings. Lack of two colours on points. Brindled colours instead of patches of colour.

LILAC CREAM POINT

Point Colour: Warm silver blue with pink overtones patched with cream. All points should be the same shade. It is desirable that lilac and cream be evident on all point areas.

Coat: Glacial white. Shadings if any are the shade of the points.

Nose Leather: Lavender, may be mottled with pink. **Paw Pads**: Lavender, may be mottled with pink.

Faw Faus. Lavender, may be motiled with pink.

Eye Colour: Clear brilliant blue. Deep blue preferred.

Objections: Improper colour nose or paw leathers. Tabby markings. Lack of two colours on points. Brindled colours instead of patches of colour.

SEAL TORTIE POINT

Point Colour: Dark seal brown with well defined patches of red/cream. All points should be the same shade. It is desirable that seal and cream be evident on all point areas.

Coat: Even pale creamy white to pale cream. Shadings if any are the shade of the points.

Nose Leather: Seal brown, may be mottled with pink.

Paw Pads: Seal brown, may be mottled with pink.

Eye Colour: Clear brilliant blue. Deep blue preferred.

Objections: Improper colour nose or paw leathers. Tabby markings. Lack of two colours on points. Brindled colours instead of patches of colour.

Refer to Breed Standard and General Preface for disqualifications and objections not listed here.

BLUE LYNX POINT

Point Colour: Silvery blue with deep grayish-blue tabby markings. All points should be the same shade.

Coat: Even bluish-white. Shadings if any are the shade of the points.

Pattern: The mask must be clearly marked with typical tabby markings including a classic "M" on the forehead. Eyes are outlined in dark pigment. Inner ear is light and a thumb print appears on the outer ear. Stripes on the legs and tail.

Nose Leather: Slate gray or brick red.

Paw Pads: Slate gray.

Eye Colour: Clear brilliant blue. Deep blue preferred.

Objections: Improper colour nose or paw leathers. Stripes or mottling on body, but consideration is to be given to shading in older cats.

CHOCOLATE LYNX POINT

Point Colour: Warm milk chocolate with darker chocolate tabby markings. All points should be the same shade.

Coat: Even ivory without lilac or blue tones. Shadings if any are the shade of the points.

Pattern: The mask must be clearly marked with typical tabby markings including a classic "M" on the forehead. Eyes are outlined in dark pigment. Inner ear is light and a thumb print appears on the outer ear. Stripes on the legs and tail.

Nose Leather: Cinnamon or pink edged with cinnamon.

Paw Pads: Cinnamon.

Eye Colour: Clear brilliant blue. Deep blue preferred.

Objections: Improper colour nose or paw leathers. Stripes or mottling on body, but consideration is to be given to shading in older cats. Blue or lilac tones.

CINNAMON LYNX POINT

Point Colour: Light reddish brown distinctly warmer and lighter than chocolate with darker cinnamon tabby markings. All points should be the same shade.

Coat: Even ivory without lilac or blue tones. Shadings if any are the shade of the points.

Pattern: The mask must be clearly marked with typical tabby markings including a classic "M" on the forehead. Eyes are outlined in dark pigment. Inner ear is light and a thumb print appears on the outer ear. Stripes on the legs and tail.

Nose Leather: Tan to pinkish-beige.

Paw Pads: Tan to pinkish-beige.

Eye Colour: Clear brilliant blue. Deep blue preferred.

Objections: Improper colour nose or paw leathers. Stripes or mottling on body, but consideration is to be given to shading in older cats. Blue or lilac tones.

REAM LYNX POINT

Point Colour: Delicate cream with darker cream tabby markings. All points should be the same shade.

Coat: Cream white. Shadings if any are the shade of the points.

Pattern: The mask must be clearly marked with typical

tabby markings including a classic "M" on the forehead. Eyes are outlined in dark pigment. Inner ear is light and a thumb print appears on the outer ear. Stripes on the legs and tail.

Nose Leather: Flesh or coral pink.

Paw Pads: Flesh or coral pink.

Eye Colour: Clear brilliant blue. Deep blue preferred.

Objections: Improper colour nose or paw leathers. Stripes or mottling on body, but consideration is to be given to shading in older cats.

FAWN LYNX POINT

Point Colour: Light lavender with pale cocoa overtones with darker lavender tabby markings. All points should be the same shade.

Coat: Glacial white. Shadings if any are the shade of the points.

Pattern: The mask must be clearly marked with typical tabby markings including a classic "M" on the forehead. Eyes are outlined in dark pigment. Inner ear is light and a thumb print appears on the outer ear. Stripes on the legs and tail.

Nose Leather: Lavender or pink edged with lavender.

Paw Pads: Lavender.

Eye Colour: Clear brilliant blue. Deep blue preferred.

Objections: Improper colour nose or paw leathers. Stripes or mottling on body, but consideration is to be given to shading in older cats.

Refer to Breed Standard and General Preface for disqualifications and objections not listed here.

Eye Colour: Clear brilliant blue. Deep blue preferred.

Objections: Improper colour nose or paw leathers. Stripes or mottling on body, but consideration is to be given to shading in older cats.

TORTIE LYNX POINT COLOURS

BLUE CREAM LYNX POINT

Point Colour: Blue with darker blue tabby markings patched with cream. Ears have paler thumbprint in center. Coat: Even bluish or creamish white. Shadings if any are the shade of the points.

Pattern: The mask must be clearly marked with typical tabby markings including a classic "M" on the forehead. Eyes are outlined in dark pigment. Inner ear is light and a thumb print appears on the outer ear. Stripes on the legs and tail.

Nose Leather: Slate gray, may be mottled with pink.

Paw Pads: Slate gray, may be mottled with pink.

Eye Colour: Clear brilliant blue. Deep blue preferred.

Objections: Improper colour nose or paw leathers.

Stripes or mottling on body, but consideration is to be given to shading in older cats.

CHOCOLATE TORTIE LYNX POINT

Point Colour: Milk chocolate with darker chocolate tabby markings patched with cream. All points should be the same shade. Ears have paler thumbprint in center.

Coat: Even ivory. Shadings if any are the shade of the points.

Pattern: The mask must be clearly marked with typical tabby markings including a classic "M" on the forehead. Eyes are outlined in dark pigment. Inner ear is light and a thumb print appears on the outer ear. Stripes on the legs and tail.

Nose Leather: Cinnamon, may be mottled with pink.

Paw Pads: Cinnamon, may be mottled with pink.

Eye Colour: Clear brilliant blue. Deep blue preferred.

Objections: Improper colour nose or paw leathers. Stripes or mottling on body, but consideration is to be given to shading in older cats.

CINNAMON TORTIE LYNX POINT

Point Colour: Light reddish-brown tabby markings patched with cream. All points should be the same shade. Ears have paler thumbprint in center.

Coat: Even ivory. Shadings if any are the shade of the points.

Pattern: The mask must be clearly marked with typical tabby markings including a classic "M" on the forehead. Eyes are outlined in dark pigment. Inner ear is light and a thumb print appears on the outer ear. Stripes on the legs and tail.

Nose Leather: Tan to pinkish-beige, may be mottled with pink.

Paw Pads: Tan to pinkish-beige, may be mottled with pink.

Eye Colour: Clear brilliant blue. Deep blue preferred.

Objections: Improper colour nose or paw leathers. Stripes or mottling on body, but consideration is to be given to shading in older cats.

FAWN TORTIE LYNX POINT

Point Colour: Light lavender tabby markings with pale cocoa overtones patched with cream. All points should be the same shade. Ears have paler thumbprint in center.

Coat: Glacial white. Shadings if any are the shade of the points.

Pattern: The mask must be clearly marked with typical tabby markings including a classic "M" on the forehead. Eyes are outlined in dark pigment. Inner ear is light and a thumb print appears on the outer ear. Stripes on the legs and tail.

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Nose Leather: Lavender, may be mottled with pink. **Paw Pads**: Lavender, may be mottled with pink.

Eye Colour: Clear brilliant blue. Deep blue preferred.

Objections: Improper colour nose or paw leathers. Stripes or mottling on body, but consideration is to be given to shading in older cats.

LILAC CREAM LYNX POINT

Point Colour: Warm silver blue with pink overtones, tabby markings a darker shade of lilac blue patched with cream. All points should be the same shade. Ears have paler thumbprint in center.

Coat: Glacial white. Shadings if any are the shade of the points.

Pattern: The mask must be clearly marked with typical tabby markings including a classic "M" on the forehead. Eyes are outlined in dark pigment. Inner ear is light and a thumb print appears on the outer ear. Stripes on the legs and tail.

Nose Leather: Lavender, may be mottled with pink.

Paw Pads: Lavender, may be mottled with pink.

Eye Colour: Clear brilliant blue. Deep blue preferred.

Objections: Improper colour nose or paw leathers. Stripes or mottling on body, but consideration is to be given to shading in older cats.

SEAL TORTIE LYNX POINT

Point Colour: Brown with darker seal brown tabby markings patched with red. All points should be the same shade. Ears have paler thumbprint in center.

Coat: Even pale cream to fawn. Shadings if any are the shade of the points.

Pattern: The mask must be clearly marked with typical tabby markings including a classic "M" on the forehead. Eyes are outlined in dark pigment. Inner ear is light and a thumb print appears on the outer ear. Stripes on the legs and tail.

Nose Leather: Seal brown, may be mottled with pink.

Paw Pads: Seal brown, may be mottled with pink.

Eye Colour: Clear brilliant blue. Deep blue preferred.

Objections: Improper colour nose or paw leathers. Stripes or mottling on body, but consideration is to be given to shading in older cats.

SMOKE POINT

White undercoat, deeply tipped with colour consistent with the corresponding base colour (solid point, tortie point, pointed bi-colour, pointed van). Points and mask appear solidly coloured with narrow band of white at base of hairs next to skin, which may be seen only when fur is parted. Nose leather and paw pad colours appropriate to the base colour.

SILVER LYNX POINT

White undercoat, deeply tipped with colour consistent with the corresponding base colour and tabby markings. (Silver lynx point, silver tortie lynx point, silver lynx point bicolour, silver tortie lynx point bi-colour, silver lynx point van, silver tortie lynx point van). Points and mask appear as a normal lynx point or tortie lynx point with narrow band of white at base of hairs next to skin, which may be seen only when fur is parted. Nose leather and paw pad colours appropriate to the base colour.

GOLDEN LYNX POINT

Pale warm honey undercoat, deeply tipped with colour consistent with the corresponding base colour and tabby markings. (golden lynx point, golden tortie lynx point, golden lynx point bi-colour, golden tortie lynx point bi-colour, golden lynx point van, golden tortie lynx point van). Points and mask appear as a normal lynx point or tortie lynx point with narrow band of warm honey at base of hairs next to skin, which may be seen only when fur is parted. Nose leather and paw pad colours appropriate to the base colour.

POINTED WITH WHITE

Pointed with White should conform to the pointed pattern with the addition of white overlaid. The face and the body should exhibit substantial white (a minimum of one-third is preferred). There must be some white on the face with enough white to indicate an inverted 'V' being preferred. Small to medium spots of colour are allowed within the white, both on the face and on the body. Blue eye colour. Disqualify no white on face.

POINTED VAN

Pointed Van should conform to the pointed pattern with the face and the body exhibiting substantial white (a minimum of one-third is preferred). Point colour is confined to the head and tail with some allowance of point colour on the legs. There must be enough white on the face to differentiate the Van pattern from an inverted 'V' of a bi-colour. One or two small spots of colour are allowed within the white, both on the face and on the body. Blue eye colour. Disqualify no white on face.

GENERAL PREFACE

The following shall apply to all breeds or as indicated:

WITHHOLD AWARDS FOR:

- 1. More or fewer than five toes on each front paw and four toes on each back paw (Pixie-Bobs are exempt from this rule). Splayed toes are an objection.
- 2. White lockets, buttons or toes on any cat, except where part of the natural colour / pattern OR unless otherwise specified in the breed standard.
- 3. Any deformity or disfigurement hereditary, congenital or acquired.
- 4. Entries which do not meet correct markings as stated. Entries must be properly and distinctly marked in accordance with the standard for all cats of the tabby variety.
- 5. A cat showing evidence of intent to deceive (i.e., the presence of powder, or chalk remaining in the coat after normal grooming, the use of tints, colour rinses or other artificial colouring concealment media, sanding or shaving, or knowledge of cosmetic surgery).
- 6. Any cat not amenable to handling by the judge, its owner or agent. All domestic breeds of cats covered in the standards are expected to be gentle and amenable to handling. Cats should be well-balanced physically and temperamentally.
- Kinks, visible or invisible. Kink is defined as rigid deflection in the line of the tail, visible or otherwise. Small, invisible bumps shall be considered a fault.
- 8. Wrong eye colour (unless otherwise specified).
- 9. Crossed eyes in any breed.
- 10. Maloccluded jaws.
- Monorchidism (absence of one testicle) or Cryptorchidism (absence of both testicles) are grounds for withholding awards.
- 12. Any entry that scores less than 90 points.

KEEP IN MIND THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. weak, receding, or protruding chin is to be considered a serious fault. Deductions can be made for chin, profile and balance.
- 2. Allowance is to be made for stud jowls in males. Usually, males are proportionally larger than females.
- 3. Allowance is to be made for seasonal variations in coat.
- 4. Allowance is to be made for faint tabby markings, except where part of the normal colour pattern.
- 5. Allowance is to be made for undeveloped eye colour

and undeveloped coat colour in kittens and young cats.

- 6. A 'blaze' two colours on the face divided down the nose— is desirable (all other factors being equal) on the numerous tortoiseshell-like colours and patterns (i.e., tortoiseshell, lilac-cream, champagne-tortie, seal tortie point, etc.)
- 7. The greenish-yellow eye colour, generally referred to as 'hazel' (not brown) is allowed where stated.
- Excellence in one aspect of the standard shall not offset deficiency in another. Inasmuch as the standard specifically describes the various parts of the cat's appearance, all judges shall conduct their work in accordance with these specifications.
- 9. All entries should posses the appropriate weight, condition and balance for its respective breed. Balance is the overall physical picture of the cat. The cat must 'fit together' and any one particular quality must not be emphasized. Judges shall not penalize any fault by a greater amount than the cat would have earned if perfect in that detail.
- 10. Judges shall penalize for bad condition indicating illness or poor care.
- 11. Natural lighting should be used wherever possible. Allowances are to be made for (harsh) artificial lighting which may distort eye and coat colour.
- 12. An entry presented in the judging ring displaying noticeable effects of a sedative (i.e., third eyelids showing, overly glassy eyes, inability to stand or sit, lack of coordination or muscle control) shall not receive an award. The judge will record NFA (No Further Award) in their judge's book.
