

ATTENTION: All cats entered must have a CCA registration number or Listing number except kittens. New rule as of June 1, 2013 – Kittens not less than 4 months but under 8 months old can be entered without a listing number, CCA registration number or CCA litter registration number. These entries will be scored for show awards but not Regional or National awards. See article 15, Section 2, of the 2013 Show rules. CCA accepts LISTED/RPN entries for Cats/Alters/Kittens registered with other associations. Please contact CCA or your Entry clerk to get this number and more details. Household pets DO NOT require registration to compete. Household pets 6 months and older must be spayed or neutered.

NO DECLAWED ENTRIES ALLOWED EXCEPT FOR JUNIOR **EXHIBITOR CLASS. SORRY!**

All fees must be received prior to entry closing date. No post-dated cheques accepted. If entry fees are not paid, your cat(s) are not entered.

In order to ensure entries are received on time, those choosing to mail their entries must allow a minimum of FIVE <u>BUSINESS</u> DAYS for receipt by the entry clerk.

Failure of payment for entries disqualifies the exhibitor and their cats from future sanctioned shows until all debts are paid to the club(s) involved. No cat may be withdrawn or entry fees withheld after the closing date of the show. No refunds after entry.

All calls regarding entries will be made COLLECT.

No kittens under the age of 3 months allowed in Show hall and registration papers may be requested.

SCORING: All registered/listed kittens, championship, premiership and household pet entries will be scored for All Canadian and Regional Awards.

SHOW HOURS: <u>9am to 5pm, Saturday</u>. <u>9am-5pm Sunday</u>. Check in from 7:30am to 8:30 am both days. Late exhibitors must personally inform all ring clerks of changes. Early departures MUST have permission to leave from the Show Manager in order not to forfeit any wins. Show hall directions and hotel accommodations will be sent out with confirmation of entries.

There will be no veterinary checkup prior to the show. Vaccination certificates of all cats present must be up-to-date. All cats or kittens for sale MUST have vaccination record and must be CCA litter registered. Documentation could be requested by the show manager.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Canadian Cat Association sanctions this show and all its rules and regulations shall be maintained. A copy of the Show Rules may be obtained (\$9.00) from The Canadian Cat Association, 5045 Oribitor Drive, Building 12, Suite 102, Mississauga, ON, L4W 4Y4 office@cca-afc.com

No liability shall attain to the club conducting or sponsoring a show in the event of a loss or damage to a cat or container. This applies to the Show Committee or to any individual member of the club. Exhibitors are responsible for a correct description of their entries and must abide by their own errors. Cats wrongfully entered in a cat show cannot receive prizes in these classes except at the discretion of the Show Committee when an error is the exhibitors.

LISTED ENTRIES: ADULT cats entered in Championship or Premiership classes must be registered with CCA or with a listed number. A listing number must be obtained from the CCA office by sending \$10 (plus HST) along with the name of the cat, registration number from the other registry, the name of the host club and the date of the show to be entered. The show entry form and entry fee must be

sent to the Entry Clerk, who will hold it until notified by the CCA with the listing number, at which time the entry will be processed provided that entries have not closed. Please note that each listing fee is only applicable for one show weekend.

KITTENS: Unregistered kittens which are registerable in CCA (i.e. a recognized breed with allowed ancestry) can be shown without purchasing a listing number. Such kittens will be entered in the show catalogue and compete normally, but will not be scored for regional or national points. Only CCA litter registered, CCA individually registered, or kittens with a listing number (\$10 fee plus HST) will be scored. All kittens competing at a show are eligible for finals and club awards. You may also acquire a RPN for your kitten.

HOUSEHOLD PETS: Must be 4 months of age or older. **HHPs 6 months or older must be neutered or spayed**. Household pets will be judged in all rings. No de-clawed entries allowed. Registration not required.

JUNIOR EXHIBITOR CLASS – 19 years and under. Junior does not have to own cat but should be on entry form as agent and indicated that they are a Jr. Exhibitor. Check EXHIBITION ONLY if not competing in any other classes at the show. Fee for Jr. Exhibitors only entering this class is \$25 exhibition only. Jr. Exhibitors can exhibit any healthy domestic cat – declaws allowed. Will be judged on grooming, presentation, temperament and general cat knowledge by one or more judges throughout the day – will be indicated on show schedule. More info provided upon entry. Does not count toward CCA regional or national awards – HONORARY ONLY!

NEW EXHIBITORS: For your protection, all cats should be brought to the show hall in a carrier. Be sure to bathe and groom your cat a day or two prior to the show, so that you are able to present it in the best possible condition. Be sure to bring grooming aids, litter pan, food dishes and cage curtains. Single cage size is approximately 22" x 22" x 22". Curtains can consist of decorated curtains, bath towels or other material plus a mat, towel or other soft material for the cage floor. If you are a novice exhibitor please indicate this on your entry form so the club can provide you with extra assistance. Cage Curtains can be lent by club members if requested with entry. KITTENS FOR SALE: Kittens must be 3 months of age or older to be in the show hall. Owners must have CCA litter registration on hand to verify age of kittens for sale if requested.

NON-VETTED SHOW: Entries are expected to have current vaccinations and to be free from fleas, ear mites, fungus (RINGWORM) and disease. (Art 7, Sec 1 & 2). All claws, front and back, must be clipped prior to benching. Any cat that is found to be ill will be removed from the show hall along with any cats they may have traveled with.

FOOD & LITTER: The club will provide a limited supply of litter. Please bring: your own cat food and dishes and a litter pan.

SHOW HOTEL: Comfort Inn Magnetic Hill, 2495 Mountain Road, Moncton- (506) 384-3175 \$97 single or double with free continental breakfast & WiFi. No pet fee. Held until March 1st. Mention Fundy Fanciers to receive this rate please.
