ATTENTION: All cats entered must have a CCA registration number or Listing number except kittens. New rule as of June 1st - Kittens not less than 4 months but under 8 months old can be entered without a listing number, CCA registration number or CCA litter registration number. These entries will be scored for show awards but not Regional or National awards. See article 15, Section 2, of the 2013 Show rules. CCA accepts LISTED (good for one show & Registration completed within 30 days) or Registration pending (good for multiple shows if registered by May of the show year end). Please contact CCA or your Entry clerk to get this number to be scored for Regional & National awards. Household pets DO NOT require registration to compete but do need to be recorded to receive Regional and national awards. Household pets 6 months and older must be spayed or neutered. NO DECLAWED ENTRIES ALLOWED.

SCORING: All registered/listed kittens, championship, premiership and household pet entries will be scored for All Canadian and Regional Awards.

Show Hours: 10:00 am to 5:00 pm, Saturday. 9am-3pm Sunday. Check in from 8:30 to 9:30 am (Sat) 8:30-9:00 am (Sun). Late exhibitors must personally inform all ring clerks of changes. Early departures MUST have permission to leave from the Show Manager in order not to forfeit any wins. Show hall directions and hotel accommodations will be sent out with confirmation of entries.

There will be no veterinary check up prior to the show. Vaccination certificates of all cats present must be up-to-date. All cats or kittens for sale MUST have vaccination record and must be CCA litter registered. Documentation could be requested by the show manager.

CAGES: The Fundy Fanciers does not provide cages for your cat to hang out in, in between judging. Exhibitors must provide their own. Single spaces are 30" long by 24" wide. Double spaces are 50" long by 24" wide. Anything not cat escapable is allowed and must be covered on 3 sides with visibility of your cat to the public in the front.

JR EXHIBITORS: At the Fundy Fanciers Cat Shows we offer a special award to Junior Exhibitors (19 years and under) learning to show their own cats and kittens at our shows. This is an honorary award only and not valid for any awards in the Canadian Cat Association. At each show a judge will offer a special ring for Junior Exhibitors before the show starts on Sunday at a special table. The judge will get the Exhibitor to present their cat to the judge and answer a few questions about their cat and CCA. If the Junior performs satisfactory the judge will present the Jr with an award of merit and a prize. At each FFCC show throughout the show year the Junior will have the opportunity to earn additional awards of Merit. With 3 they will be presented with a Bronze level award with 6 a silver and with 9 a gold! So kids start young and start collecting!!!! Juniors do not have to own their exhibition cat but should be able to handle and present the cat. Cats can be exhibition only entries. We are now offering for extra fun a special award for best Junior Decorated show cage.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Canadian Cat Association sanctions this show and all its rules and regulations shall be maintained. A copy of the Show Rules may be obtained (\$9.00) from The Canadian Cat Association, 5045 Oribitor Drive, Building 12, Suite 102, Mississauga, ON, L4W 4Y4, email: office@cca-afc.com

Anyone attending a CCA sanctioned cat show---which includes but is not limited to exhibitors, spectators, vendors---shall behave in a sportsmanlike and polite manner. Confrontations, bullying or other unprofessional behavior reported to the Show Manager will not be tolerated and will render the person or persons responsible to ejection from the show hall and possible disciplinary action.

No cat may be withdrawn or entry fees withheld after the closing date of the show.

Failure of payment for entries disgualifies the exhibitor and their cats from future sanctioned shows until all debts are paid to the club(s) involved.

No liability shall attain to the club conducting or sponsoring a show in the event of a loss or damage to a cat or container. This applies to the Show Committee or to any individual member of the club. Exhibitors are responsible for a correct description of their entries and must abide by their own errors. Cats wrongfully entered in a cat show cannot receive prizes in these classes except at the discretion of the Show Committee when an error is the exhibitors.

LISTED ENTRIES: All cats entered in Championship & Premiership must be registered with the Canadian Cat Association with the exception of listed entries. Kittens may be entered with a CCA litter registration number or no number (but not eligible for Regional or National awards). Listed entries must have a CCA listing number in order to be entered. A listing number must be obtained from the CCA office (please contact for price \$10 + tax) along with the name of the cat, registration number from another registry, the name of the host club and the date of the show to be entered either by E-mail or mail.

The entry must be registered within 30 days of the show to retain points achieved during the listed show. The show entry form and entry fee must be sent to the entry clerk who will hold it until notified by CCA with the listing number at which time the entry will be processed provided that entries have not closed. Please note that each listing fee is only applicable for one show weekend.

HOUSEHOLD PETS: Must be 4 months of age or older. HHPs 6 months or older must be neutered or spayed. Household pets will be judged in all rings. No de-clawed entries allowed. Registration not required.

KITTENS FOR SALE: Kittens must be 3 months of age or older to be in the show hall. Owners must have CCA litter registration on hand to verify age of kittens for sale if requested.

NON-VETTED SHOW: Entries are expected to have current vaccinations and to be free from fleas, ear mites, fungus (RINGWORM) and disease. (Art 7, Sec 1 & 2). All claws, front and back, must be clipped prior to benching. Any cat that is found to be ill will be removed from the show hall along with any cats they may have traveled with.

FOOD & LITTER: The club will provide litter. Please bring: your own cat food and dishes and a litter pan.

SHOW HOTEL: Comfort Inn Dartmouth 1-902-463-9900, 456 Windmill Road \$113 (15 min from Show Hall). Held until October 20th. Mention Fundy Fanciers for group rate.

NEW EXHIBITORS: For your protection, all cats should be brought to the show hall in a carrier. Be sure to bathe and groom your cat a day or two prior to the show, so that you are able to present it in the best possible condition. Be sure to bring grooming aids, litter pan, food dishes and cage with a pop up cage or kennel. If you are a novice exhibitor please indicate this on your entry form so the club can provide extra assistance. Mentors available. CONTACT New Exhibitor Coordinator:
