Show Hours: <u>10am to 5pm</u> Check in from 8:30 to 9:30 am. Late exhibitors must personally inform all ring clerks of changes. <u>Early</u> <u>departures MUST have permission to leave from the Show Manager</u> in order not to forfeit any wins. This will be strictly enforced.

Show hall directions and hotel accommodations will be sent out with confirmation of entries.

CAGES: The Fundy Fanciers does not provide cages for your cat to hang out in, in between judging. Exhibitors must provide their own. Single spaces are 30" long by 24" wide. Double spaces are 50" long by 24" wide. Anything not cat escapable is allowed and must be covered on 3 sides with visibility of your cat to the public in the front.

HOTELS: A limited number of single and double rooms are held at Comfort Inn, 560 Bedford Highway, Halifax, includes breakfast and WiFi. Contact Kim Langille (kim.langille@unb.ca) to obtain a room.

LUNCHES: Meals and snacks are not available on site. Exhibitors should make their own arrangements.

<u>STROLLERS</u>: As at all Fundy Fanciers shows, pet strollers are not permitted and can not be stored on site – please leave the strollers in your vehicle.
