RULES & REGULATIONS

This show shall be sanctioned by the Canadian Cat Association and all its rules & regulations shall be maintained. A copy of the Show Rules & Classifications are available FREE on the CCA-AFC website: <u>www.cca-afc.com</u>. For paper copies, please call 905-232-3481 or email <u>office@cca-afc.com</u> or mail your request to Canadian Cat Association, Unit 118, 1 Centre Street, Toronto, ON M1J 3B4.

No liability shall attain to the club conducting or sponsoring a show in the event of loss or damage to a cat or container. This applies to the Show Committee or to any individual member of the club.

Exhibitors are responsible for a correct description of their entries and must abide by their own errors. Cats wrongfully entered in the wrong classification cannot receive prizes in the wrong class.

No cat may be withdrawn or entry fees withheld after the closing date of the show. Failure of payment for entries disqualifies the exhibitor and all their cats from future shows until all debts are paid to the club(s) involved. Exhibitors are permitted to withdraw their cats under any judge(s) officiating at the show, provided it is stated at the time of entry.

LISTED ENTRIES: All cats entered in Championship, Premiership, or Kitten classes must be registered or registerable with CCA-AFC. Cats without a CCA-AFC permanent registration number can compete using a temporary number issued by the CCA-AFC Office (office@cca-afc.com). Kittens may be entered with a CCA-AFC litter registration number, Registered Pending Number, or as unregistered listed entries.

HOUSEHOLD PETS: Must be 4 months of age or older. Cats 6 months or older MUST be neutered or spayed but NOT DECLAWED.

KITTENS FOR SALE: Exhibitor must have at least 1 entry to obtain a sales cage. Kittens for sale must be 3 calendar months of age or older & must provide proof of vaccinations. Owners must have CCA-AFC litter registration on hand to verify age of kittens for sale; failure to provide this will result in the breeder/agent & all their entries being asked to leave the show hall. No refunds will be issued. No kittens/cats may be sold at the show without a sales cage. Limit 1 cat/2 kittens per single cage or 3 cats/5 kittens per double cage. All cats/kittens sold from the show hall must leave in a carrier & be escorted by the breeder/agent.

NON-VETTED SHOW: Entries are expected to have current vaccinations & to be free from fleas, ear mites, fungus, & disease (see Article 7, Sections 1 & 2). All claws must be clipped prior to benching. Any cat found to be ill will be removed from the show hall along with any entries they may have travelled with.

LITTER: The club will provide litter. Please bring cat food, dishes & a litterbox.

AGILITY: Agility will be operated by an experienced, trained Agility Ringmaster. Each day is a separate competition, with placements awarded to the top 10 cats each day. Agility entries can be submitted ahead of time (with a discount) or on the day of the show (ONLY for cats already entered in the show). Agility entries do not have to be entered in the regular show, but the owner **MUST** have cats entered in the regular show.

SCORING: All eligible entries will be scored for All Canadian & Regional Awards. In order to receive an award, the entry must be registered with CCA-AFC by the end of the show season. Best of Best will be awarded each day.

EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN: All entries must check in with the Entry Clerk between 7:15-8 AM on Saturday and 7:30-8:30 AM on Sunday. Saturday judging will begin at 8:30 AM **sharp**; Sunday judging will begin at 9 AM. Show hours are from 9 AM to 3 PM on Saturday and 9 AM to 4:30 PM Sunday. Early departures **must** have permission to leave from the Show Manager in order not to forfeit any wins. Show hall directions will be sent out with confirmation of entries.

PEOPLE FOOD AVAILABILITY: Food will be available on-site at the venue's snack bar & restaurant.

BENCHING: Double cage size is approximately 22"x44"x22". Requests limited to 1 per exhibitor. No requests for 1-day entries.

NEW EXHIBITORS: All cats must be brought to the show hall in a carrier. Cats should be bathed & groomed before the show. You will need to bring food, bowls, litterbox, grooming tools, and any beds/toys your cat may want. If you do not have your own cage, please select "Wire Cage" on the entry form. Wire cages are 22"d x 44"x 22"h. Please bring cage curtains, which you can make with towels, tablecloths, flat sheets, or blankets. There will be an info session before the show starts on Saturday at 8 AM.
